

## ComoNaz Church Required Face Mask Policy

Due to the new City of Columbia Ordinance that now requires mandatory face masks to be worn in public places, beginning July 10th through October 8th, 2020, ComoNaz Church will also be complying with this new mandatory face mask requirement during our in-person worship services and all weekly activities or visits that take place at ComoNaz Church. If you or a family member feels that wearing a face mask creates either physical or mental health complications for you, we encourage you to choose our on-line worship service option, until the City ordinance is lifted or expires. ComoNaz Church will continue to provide disposable face masks for any guests on Sunday morning or throughout the week. Please note the following exemptions to this requirement listed below:

### **The only exemptions or adjustments to this requirement are:**

- \* Those under the age of 10 years are not required to wear a face mask.
- \* Masks may be taken off while seated, as long as you are spaced at least 6 feet apart from non-family members, and you must place your face mask on as you leave from your seat to move around inside.
- \* If you are inside the church building during the week and immediate family members are the only ones present you do not need to wear a mask.
- \* The pastor, Worship Team members, or any designated individual asked or required to speak, may remove their face mask while on the worship platform to perform their duties during the service or practice service (as long as 6 feet distancing is being observed), but must then place their face masks back on as they step off the platform onto the sanctuary floor to be with our ComoNaz family and guests.
- \* Those working in the sound booth room, may remove their face mask, as long as 6 feet distancing is being observed, but must wear their mask when exiting the sound room.

Thank you for your continued cooperation and support as we align ourselves with these new guidelines and as we continue to move forward in ministry.
